Dear Mr. O'Reilly:

Thank you for your consideration of Carolina Power and Light Company's denial of the violation in the subject report. Carolina Power and Light has reviewed your June 29, 1984 staff evaluation of the denial and provides the requested information.

1. Corrective Steps Which Have Been Taken and Results Achieved.

In order to alleviate any concern the NRC may have on control of welding electrodes, Carolina Power and Light Company has made the following conservative changes to WP-502 in Revision 11.

- A. Coated electrodes returned to the issue station which were not issued in a portable rod caddy will be destroyed regardless of exposure time.
- B. Coated electrodes issued in a portable rod caddy shall be used or destroyed once they have been removed from the caddy.

2. Corrective Steps Which Will be Taken to Avoid Further Violation.

The corrective steps mentioned above should prevent recurrence.

3. Date When Full Compliance Will be Achieved.

Full compliance has been achieved.


