Gentlemen:

On March 31, 1995, Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) submitted a request for license amendents for the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant (BSEP), Unit Nos. 1 and 2. These proposed amendments would revise the Technical Specifications by adding an exemption from the requirements of Technical Specification 3.0.4 to Specification 3/4.8.1.1. The Company withdraws the request and plans to re-examine the need for the Technical Specification 3.0.4 exemption to Specification 3/4.8.1.1 as part of our project for converting to the BWR-4 Improved Technical Specifications.
