In November 1995, Region III received Revision 4H of the Byron Station's Annex to the Generating Stations Emergency Plan. We have reviewed this revision and determined that it is acceptable and does not decrease the effectiveness of your emergency planning.

Revision 4H included new information on the joint public information center. A clarification was provided on the criteria for determining if site evacuees should be reassembled at an offsite location to be monitored for contamination. One of several backup medical care facilities was deleted. Some redundant or unneeded information was deleted from the Annex. Revision 4H also included several other information updates and editorial changes.
