By letter dated April 10, 1995, as supplemented by letters dated November 3 and December 14, 1995, Detroit Edison submitted proposed changes to the Fermi 2 emergency action levels (EALs) contained in Revision 13 to the Fermi 2 Radiological Emergency Response Preparedness (RERP) Plan. The proposed EALs incorporate the guidance in NUMARC/NESP-007, Revision 2, "Methodology for Development of Emergency Action Levels." NUMARC/NESP-007 was endorsed by the staff in Regulatory Guide 1.101, Revision 3, "Emergency Planning and Preparedness for Nuclear Power Reactors," as an acceptable method for meeting the requirements of 10 CFR 50.47(b)(4) and Appendix E to 10 CFR Part 50.

The staff has completed its review of your submittals. Based on the review, the staff has determined that the proposed changes meet the requirements of 10 CFR 50.47(b)(4) and Appendix E to 10 CFR Part 50. The details of the staff's review are contained in the enclosed Safety Evaluation.

The State and local governments have concurred on the EALs contained in the April 10, 1995, submittal. As discussed with your staff, you are reminded that in accordance with Appendix E to 10 CFR Part 50, you must ensure that the State and local governments agree with the EAL changes made subsequent to the April 10, 1995, submittal.
