SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION

(NRC INSPECTION REPORT NOS. 50-369/92-08 AND 50-370/92-08)

This refers to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) inspection conducted by Mr. P. K. VanDoorn on February 23, 1992 - March 21, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your McGuire facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed inspection report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice). We are concerned about the violations because prompt corrective action was not taken for two days when the diesel fuel oil level was identified to be below Technical Specification requirements and because of the multiple examples of configuration control errors that impacted multiple plant systems and functional areas of responsibility.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. In your response, you should document the specific actions taken and any additional actions you plan to prevent recurrence. Other specific responses required should be addressed as appropriate. After reviewing your response to this Notice, including your proposed corrective actions and the results of future inspections, the NRC will determine whether further NRC enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with NRC regulatory requirements.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and its enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Rcom.

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The responses directed by this letter and its enclosures are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, Pub. L. No. 96-511.
