By let er dated January 9, 1992, Entergy Operations, Inc., requested relief from the requirements of ASME Section XI in accordance with 10 CFR 50.55a(g)(iv) and 10 CFR 50.55a(g)(6)(i). Your submittal requests permission to permanently extend the time limit for filing the inservice inspection summary required by ASME Section XI, 1977 Edition through Summer Addenda, IWA-6230, to 180 days following the completion of the required inspections. The ASME Code, as written, requires that these reports be submitted within 90 days of the completion of the required inspections.

You have based your request on your previous inability to complete these reports within the ASME Code Section IWA-6230 filing time limit and on your desire to minimize overtime expenditures for your personnel.

The NRC staff has reviewed your request, and based on its understanding of the nature and extent of the resources required to prepare the required report. and based also on it, experience with numerous other utilities that have been able to meet the ASME Code schedular requirement, the staff cannot conclude that it is impractical for Entergy Operations Inc., to submit the required report within 90 days of the completion of the inspections.

Accordingly, your request for relief is denied.
