Subject: Application for Amendment to NRC Export License to Bangladesh

Reference: NRC Export License No. XR126, with amendments

Dear Mr. Peterson:

General Atomics hereby makes application, pursuant to 10 CFR 110, for an amendment to NRC Export License No. XR126 to Bangladesh. An amendment is required to allow for the shipment of spare parts in support of the TRIGA Mark II research reactor delivered to Bangladesh under License XR126. Furthermore, GA wishes to extend the period of the license by six (6) years, until 23 June 1998. Our suggested wording for the amendment follows:

*The license is amended as follows:

- 1) Specifically designed and prepared replacement parts and components for use in a TRIGA Mark II Research Reactor. The value of parts exported not to exceed \$500,000. *
- 2) The licensee is authorized to re-export above items that are returned to the licensee for warranty repair or replacement.
- 3) The expiration date of the license is extended from 23 June 1992 to 23 June 1998.*
