

SUBJECT: OPERATOR SHIFT EXPERIENCE

On June 27, 1984, representatives of Georgia Power Company (GPC) met with NRC Region II personnel in Atlanta, Georgia to discuss their program to acquire operating experience for plant Vogtle. The attendance list is attached as Attachment A to this summary. The meeting was held at the request of Georgia Power Company.

GPC representatives presented and explained their program for gaining experienced operating personnel for plant Vogtle. It consisted of licensing GPC employees at V. C. Summer and J. M. Farley Nuclear Plants and assigning them to a shift at these sites until transferred to GPC's training program for licensing at plant Vogtle. GPC provided draft copies of license applications for the candidates entering this program for NRC comment.

The NRC Region II staff fully supported the program presented by GPC and agreed to provide license application comments after a detailed review is completed.
