SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT 50-313/92-07; 50-368/92-07 (NOTICE OF VIOLATION)

This refers to the inspection conducted by Meses. L. J. Smith and K. D. Weaver, and Messrs. I. Barnes, S. J. Campbell, M. A. Satorius, and M. X. Franovich of this office March 1-28, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Arkansas Nuclear One, Units 1 and 2, facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with you and those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. The areas included onsite followup of licensee event reports, items of regional interest, onsite response to events, monthly maintenance observation, bimonthly surveillance observation, operational safety verification, and refueling activities.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation. We are concerned that test personnel deviated from the test procedure and pressurized the service water system for hydrostatic testing with an unauthorized revised test boundary established.

Although 10 CFR 2.201 requires you to submit to this office, within 20 days of your receipt to this Notice, a written statement of explanation, we note that the corrective actions being taken adequately address the concerns identified within the Notice of Violation and these actions were reviewed during this inspection. Therefore, no response with respect to this matter is required.

It was also found that the failure of both your primary and secondary analysts to identify seven tubes with indications near the tube sheet on the hot leg side of Steam Generator A during Refueling Outage 2R8 was a violation of 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix B, Criterion V. The violation is not being cited because your efforts to identify and correct the violation met the criteria in Appendix C, paragraph VII, B.(2), of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," 10 CFR Part 2.
