SEQUOYAH NUCLEAR PLANT UNITS 1 AND 2 - NRC-OIE REGION II INSPECTION REPORT
50-327/83-13 AND 50-328/83-13

The following information concerns OIE inspection report Nos. 50-327/83-13 and 50-328/83-13 and the TVA response submitted to you from D. S. Kammer on October 14, 1983. TVA's response to deficiency 327,328/83-13-08 committed TVA to revise the Sequoyah emergency monitoring implementing procedures and the Muscle Shoals Emergency Center emergency monitoring implementing procedures by January 31, 1984. We provided revised completion dates on January 31 and April 2, 1984.


While revisions to the emergency monitoring implementing procedures have been prepared, we have been unable to implement them by May 1, 1984 as our latest commitment has stated. This was due to a shift in manpower and resources in order to repair an unanticipated maintenance problem which was delaying plant startup. Our revised expected completion date is June 1, 1984.
