Subject: BOMB THREAT

At 11:05 a.m., August 27, 1984, an unidentified male telephoned the security post at the 100' elevation of Unit 1 on an internal line and told the security guard, "This is a bomb threat. This is a bomb threat. There is a bomb planted in containment. It will go off in about 45 minutes." When asked which unit, the caller replied, "Unit 1". The licensee implemented their Contingency Plan and notified local law enforcement authorities and the FBI. Personnel were evacuated from containment and bomb search teams were deployed. No bomb was found and there was no explosion.

This Preliminary Notification is current as of 2:36 p.m., August 27 when the licensee terminated the Unusual Event. This PN is issued for information only. The resident inspector followed licensee actions. The State of New Jersey was informed.
