MEMORANDUM AND ORDER (Requesting Information from Alabama Power Company)

As we noted in our April 22, 1992 memorandum and order requesting information from the NRC staff, in preparation for the upcoming portion of the evidentiary hearing concerning the parties' rebuttal and surrebuttal testimony, the Board is reviewing the materials cited by the parties in support of their responsive testimony. In examining Alabama Power Company (APCo) Exhibit 53, which is referenced at page 120 of Volume II of APCo's surrebuttal testimony, we find that our understanding of this test graph excerpted from the CONAX IPS-170 report would be aided by some additional explanation.

To this end, we request that by close of business on Tuesday, May 12, 1992, APCo provide the Board and the staff with copies of any additional portion of the CONAX IPS-107

ort that explains the basis for the test graph admitted as APCo Exhibit 53. In the event the staff has any comments regarding the completeness of the explanatory material supplied to the Board by APCo, it should provide those comments by noon E.D.T. on Friday, May 15, 1992.
