Dear Chairman Palladino and Members of the Commission:

By letter dated August 20, 1984 (DCL-84-287) (attached hereto), Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PGand.") has requested that Facility Operating License DPR-76 for the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 1, be amended to extend its term yet again. As you know, the Joint Intervenors have previously requested hearings pursuant to § 189(a) of the Atomic Energy Act, to be held prior to Commission action on similar amendment applications by PGandE, which requests have been denied by the Commission. Those denials are currently on appeal to the U.S. Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit.

For the reasons previously articulated in support of their requests for hearings on PGandE's prior amendment applications, the Joint Intervenors hereby oppose PGandE's License Amendment Request No. 84-09 and request a hearing pursuant to § 189(a) of the Atomic Energy Act, to be held prior to the Commission's decision on the application. To that end, the Joint Intervenors incorporate herein by reference their
