Dear Sirs:

Recent conversation with T. W. Dexter of the NRC Region IV Office has convinced Houston Lighting & Power Company (HL&P) that two letters sent to you near the end of last year contained Safeguards Information pursuant to 10CFR73.21.

The letters in question, HL&P correspondence numbers ST-HL-AE-3942 and ST-HL-AE-3943, dated December 10, 1991 and December 13, 1991, respectively, concerning security measures associated with temporary construction and HL&P's response to Notice of Violation 91-21. The letters have been determined to contain Safeguards Information in accordance with 10CFR73.21(b).

Although neither letter described a reduction in security effectiveness as required by the Physical Security Plan, the letters did doscribe potential vulnerabilities. HL&P has taken the conservative approach and reclassifier the letters as Safeguards Information. HL&P has taken actions to control remaining copies of the letters in accordance with 10CFR73.21, recover or properly control any copies of the letters which were distributed and provide the non-safeguarded portion of the letters as needed.
