Reference: Letter from William J. Jump to Document Control Desk Dated September 27, 1991 (ST-HL-AE-3858)

As noted in the letter referenced above, Houston Lighting & Power Company (HL&P) is refurbishing the former South Texas Project Electric Generating Station (STPEGS) onsite administration building as a Maintenance Operations Facility (MOF). Construction work associated with the MOF project has resulted in a number of temporary changes in the configuration of the Protected Area boundary. Phase I temporary changes were described in the referenced letter. Implementation of Phase II temporary changes is expected to begin by December 15, 1991.

Phase II temporary changes are as follows:

## Barriers

The temporary Protected Area boundary will be extended to exclude the entire MOF from the Protected Area. The temporary boundary is depicted in Figure 1 (attached).

A temporary gatehouse will be installed to control access/egress to the MOF machine shop from the Protected Area. The gatehouse door and badge storage will be protected arrangement is depicted in rigure 2 (attached).
