SUBJECT: FORCED SHUTDOWN IN EXCESS OF 72 HOURS

CP&L announced at 12:00 p.m. on April 21, 1992, that management decided to shuldown both Brunswick units because of a concern relating to the structural integrity of concrete walls in the diesel building. CP&L had previously identified seismic concerns for the block walls in the diesel building. Investigations and inspections of other walls indicated other deficiencies that would question the survivability of safety-related equipment in the event of a seismic event. The licensee has not decided on the length of the dual-unit outage.

The licensee has notified the State of North Carolina and local officials. The NRC received initial notification of this event by telephone call from the licensee at 12:00 p.m. on April 21, 1992.
