I have written you a recent letter regarding my concerns about the Limerick Nuclear Station. As I explained in my letter, an in-depth article by the Phila. Inquirer, dated June 24, 1984, citing the malpractices of various utilities, caused me to have renewed concern for the integrity of state run utilities.

I again reiterate, the nuclear industry is such a highly technical, volatile one, my heart will only rest 'til it is nationalized.

However, the above is somewhat repetitive. This letter relates to the audacity of Pennsylvania officials to accept, without equivocation, PEMA's setting up its own drill date. Also, that PEMA would consider giving the "exercise" any mark considering that critical parts of the population were not involved (school kids).

It also designated Methacton as a host school even though it is in the EPZ.
