Gentlemen:

We have received a copy of the following applications which were filed with the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (ONRR) for review in connection with the Edwin I. Hatch Plant Unit Nos. 1 and 2:

1. A July 9, 1982 application for Technical Specification organizational changes for Unit Nos. 1 and 2. A Class II fee (\$1,200) and a Class I fee (\$400) were remitted with your request pursuant to 10 CFR 170.22 of the March 23, 1978 regulations.
2. A November 11, 1982 application for Technical Specification changes relating to feedwater temperature reduction for Unit No. 2. A Class III fee (\$4,000) was remitted with your application pursuant to 10 CFR 170.22 of the March 23 regulations. This application was withdrawn by letter dated August 2, 1983.
3. An October 24, 1983 application for Technical Specification changes relating to onsite plant organization, Quality Assurance organization, and the Plant Review Board for Units Nos. 1 and 2. A Class II fee (\$1,200) and a Class I fee (\$400) were remitted with your application.

Based on information provided by the ONRR staff, it has been determined that:

1. A refund of \$1,600 is appropriate for Item 1 since the ONRR staff has informed us that this application contained information which is considered as being supplemental to your August 12, 1980 application. A Class III fee (\$4,000) and a Class I fee (\$400) were remitted with the August 12, 1980 request.

2. A refund of \$4,000 is appropriate for Item 2. Under the provisions of 10 CFR 170.12(a), the USNRC may retain fees for withdrawn applications. However, for applications filed prior to June 20, 1984, it is NRC policy not to retain fees when no review has commenced prior to the withdrawal of an application. The ONRR staff has informed us that no review had commenced on your November 11, 1982 request prior to its withdrawal. On this basis, we have determined that an exemption pursuant to 10 CFR 170.11(b) from the fee requirements is authorized by law and such exemption is otherwise in the public interest and is hereby granted for this application.

3. A Class III fee (\$4,000) and a Class I fee (\$400) are appropriate for Item 3 since the review will involve consideration of changes that are more than administrative or pro forma in nature and involve a duplicate unit. Therefore, an additional sum of \$2,800 is due for this request.

On the one hand, a refund of \$5,600 is due your Company for Items 1 and 2 above and on the other hand, a sum of \$2,800 is due the USNRC for Item 3 above. We are applying \$2,800 of the \$5,600 due your Company for Items 1 and 2 to the \$2,800 due the USNRC for Item 3. Accordingly, we are concurrently authorizing the Division of Accounting and Finance to refund \$2,800 to your Company. We hope this transaction meets with your approval. If the ONRR staff's final review of Item 3 reveals that these fees are not appropriate, you will be notified and any necessary adjustments will be made.
