SUMMARY

Scope:

This routine, unannounced inspection was conducted in the areas of Physical Security Program for Power Reactors. The specific areas evaluated were: Management Support; Security Program Plans; Audits; Protected and Vital Area Barriers, Detection and Assessment Aids; Protected and Vital Area Access Control-Personnel, Packages and Vehicles; Alarm Stations and Communications; and Security Training.

Results:

In the areas inspected, one NRC identified violation and one non-cited licensee identified violation were identified.

The NRC identified violation pertained to assessment capabilities; see Paragraph 2.f. The non-cited violation pertained to unsecured safeguards information; see Paragraph 2.b. Otherwise the security program continues to provide appropriate protection of the vital resources of Plant St. Lucie. The security management and security force members are well trained, motivated, and professional in their performance of duty.
