Dear Mr. Keppler:

Reference (d) identified three companies who supplied materials during intitial construction at LaSalle who were recipients of Ray Miller material.

Reference (e) stated that from a review of QC documentation on the three companies, we felt confident that no fraudulent material supplied by Ray Miller was used at LaSalle County.

We have now received letters from each of the vendors advising us that Ray Miller Inc. supplied material was <u>not</u> used on equipment or components supplied for LaSalle County Station.

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This completes our actions in response to IE Bulletin 83-07 and Supplements 1 and 2.

To the best of my knowledge and belief the statements contained herein are true and correct. In some respects these statements are not based on my personal knowledge but upon information furnished by other Commonwealth Edison employees, consultants, and contractors. Such information has been reviewed in accordance with Company practice and I believe it to be reliable.
