HOPE CREEK GENERATING STATION
DOCUMENT NO. 50-354

By letter NLR-N91127, dated July 25, 1991, Public Service Electric and Gas Company (PSE&G) submitted an application to amend Appendix A of Facility Operating License No. NPF-57 in accordance with 10CFR50.90. This amendment would modify, in accordance with the provisions and guidance of Generic Letter 88-01, several sections of Hope Creek Generating station (HCGS) Technical Specifications (TS). Additionally, TS 3.4.3.1, Leakage Detection Systems, was rewritten to eliminate ambiguities and to include provisions supported by the BWROG (and recently promulgated by the NRC in Supplement 1 to Generic Letter 88-01).

Our description of the requested amendment, supporting information and analyses for the change, and the basis for a no significant hazards consideration determination provided in our original amendment request are not changed by this supplement. The changes proposed in this supplement (in Attachment 1) include a minor alteration of the wording originally proposed for TS 4.0.0 and a supporting statement in Basis Section 3/4.4.3.1 regarding the accuracy of our proceduralized leakage calculations.

Pursuant to the requirements of 10CFR50.91(b)(1), PSE&G has provided a copy of this supplemental information to the State of New Jersey.


