On March 27, 1992, GPU Nuclear Corporation, licensee of the Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station, submitted the subject amendment to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). This Technical Specification Charge Request (TSCR) proposes to change the surveillance interval of the Standby Liquid Control System to once every 24 months.
