SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT 50-382/92-10 (NOTICE OF VIOLATION)

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. L. T. Ricketson of this office on April 13-17, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for Waterford Steam Electric Station, Unit 3. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with you and those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice). The violation involved the failure of workers to sign in under the appropriate radiation work permit. We are concerned about this violation, because it indicates a lack of attention by some radiation workers and health physics department.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. In your response, you should document the specific actions taken and any additional actions you plan to prevent recurrence. After reviewing your response to this Notice, including your proposed corrective actions and the results of future inspections, the NRC will determine whether further NRC enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with NRC regulatory requirements.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC'S "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

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
