SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO GENERIC LETTER 91-11, "RESOLUTION OF GENERIC ISSUE 48, 'LCO'S FOR CLASS 1E VITAL INSTRUMENT BUSES,' AND 49, 'INTERLOCKS AND LCO'S FOR CLASS 1E TIE BREAKERS,' PURSUANT TO 10 CFR 50.54(f)" FOR CRYSTAL RIVER UNIT 3 (TAC NO. M82402)

On July 18, 1991, the NRC issued Generic Letter (GL) 91-11 which contained the staff resolution of Generic Issues 48 and 49. The GL required that licensees certify that procedures exist which contain time limitations and surveillance requirements for vital instrument buses (VIB), inverters or other onsite power sources for VIB, and tie breakers. If procedures do not exist, a justification demonstrating the reasons why the controls are not needed is required.

By letter dated October 31, 1991, you responded to the GL. You stated that "[t]he recommendations of the Generic Letter are already reflected in the operation and procedures of Crystal River Unit 3 (CR-3)."

The staff finds that your response meets the reporting requirements set forth in GL 91-11.

This completes the staff's activities on TAC No. M82402.
