Please refer to my original letter, Section 4.

- 4.1 This Power Supply is part of a larger assembly sold to New York Power Authority. We contacted John Boccio at NYPA (914)739-8200, Ext. 455, and he checked the Power Supply and verified that it met the minimum gap requirement.
- 4.2 We contacted our Field Service Engineer who was stationed at this address, Paul Knickman (301) 561-3600. He checked the supply and found it met the minimum gap requirements.
- 4.3 These Power Supplies are at the Hope Creek Nuclear Plant, we contacted Jerry Issacs (415) 768-2537 and described the problem. We sent Paul Knickman (Computer Products Field Serivce Engineer, stationed in Timonium, MD) to the site. He found 3 Power Supplies with potential problems, all three have been replaced.
