ORDER REGARDING FOE MOTION TO SET ASIDE PARTIAL INITIAL DECISION AND MOTION TO REOPEN RECORD

FOE filed a motion to set aside the August 29, 1984 Second Fartial Initial Decision and to reopen the record on its pipeline accident Contentions V-3a and 3b based on an NRC Staff Board Notification (BN-84-142, dated August 20, 1984). FOE's motion is dated September 1, 1984, but is postmarked September 3 and was received through regular mail by the Board on September 6, 1984.

The one page motion does not by its terms request a stay, although this may have been the intent of FOE. (FOE's <u>pro se</u> representative has had occasion in this case to know how to expressly request a stay, and to know what the criteria for a stay are.) In any event, FOE presents no basis to support a stay, and we perceive none. Accordingly, our decision remains in effect.

The NRC Staff's and Applicant's answers to FCE's motion to reopen shall update the information, by affidavits of appropriate officials with knowledge of the facts, contained in the Board Notification.
