SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION (NRC INSPECTION REPORT NOS, 50-348/92-09 AND 50-364/92-09)

This refers to the inspection conducted by G. F. Maxwell of this office on March 9 through April 13, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Farley facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, and at various times during the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violatica (Notice). We are concerned about the violation because of a lack of timeliness and an inadequacy in the performance of proposed corrective actions. These corrective actions, if performed, may have prevented the Unit 2 reactor trip on March 6, 1992.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. In your response, you should document the specific actions taken and any additional actions you plan to prevent recurrence. After reviewing your response to this Notice, including your proposed corrective actions and the results of future inspections, the NRC will determine whether forther NRC enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with NRC regulatory requirements.

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In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

The responses directed by this letter and the enclosed Notices(s) are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paper work Reduction Act of 1980, Pub. L. No. 96-511.
