General Items

FSV requested that the French visit be scheduled for the afternoon of March 14, 1996 instead of March 15, 1996. FSV is on a four day work schedule (Mike Weber note schedule change).

Plant Status

Work continues on the decontamination. Primary focus of the decontamination work is in PCRV. Radiation levels in PCRV have dropped after some initial decontamination. FSV is preparing for PCRV wash down. Work is continuing on the hydrolyzing (10,000 psi). Hydrolyzing is progress slowly and FSV is modifying their technique to see if it will increase productivity. Hydrolyzing is providing 4 passes for each pipe.

Currently 233,000 cubic waste has been removed. Approximately 5000 cubic feet remain. 115,000 cubic feet were shipped to Richland, 10,000 cubic feet were shipped to Betty, and the remaining was shipped to SEG for volume reduction.

Final Survey work continues. Group A has 100% percent data collected and 83% analyzed. Group B 83% data collected and 42% analyzed. Group C 90% collected and 37% analyzed.
