Dear Mr. & Mrs. Ellman:

I have received your letter dated December 20, 1995, and the corresponding attachment (letter from Zionomics to Doug Ellman, dated December 14, 1995). In the attachment, Zionomics proposes to encapsulate the magnesium-thorium sheet metal fragment in concrete and transport it to Barnwell, South Carolina for disposal. The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) finds the proposed approach to be acceptable.

As indicated in our October 6, 1995, letter your facility at 1950 West Fort Street, Detroit, Michigan should be released for unrestricted use following disposal of the sheet metal fragment. I will recommend that the Commission release your facility and remove it from the Site Decommissioning Management Plan list following NRC receipt of your Certificate of Disposition of Materials (NRC Form 314). Please attach a copy of the Disposal Shipment Manifest and a signed acknowledgement of receipt from the Barnwell disposal site or the waste collector. Enclosed are copies of NRC Form 314 for your use.
