ORDER

CLI-84-16

On September 5, 1984, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board issued an "Order Reconsidering Summary Disposition of Phase I and Phase II Low-Power Testing." The effect of the September 5 Order is to resolve certain offsite emergency power issues in favor of permitting the Long Island Lighting Company (LILCO) to conduct fuel loading and low power testing as proposed in Phases I and II of its low power testing program. However, in the present posture of the case, no such fuel loading and low power testing can be undertaken without action by the Commission itself.

Any party's written views on whether the Licensing Board's September 5, 1984 Order may serve as the basis for issuance of a license for Phase I and Phase II of LILCO's low power testing program should be received by the Secretary of the Commission no later than c.o.b. Friday,


