**SUBJECT:** PULSTAR Nuclear Reactor Emergency Drill


As required by the North Carolina State University PULSTAR Nuclear Reactor Emergency Plan and Procedures, the annual drill is scheduled for 21 December 1995 (Thursday). A representative from your organization is invited to participate and observe or comment on the drill.

For the purpose of drill integrity, the specifics of the drill other than the date can not be provided at this time. This drill will be announced and is designed to be comprehensive in nature. Several organizations from on campus and off campus agencies will be participating. Several parts of the PULSTAR Emergency Plan will be tested during the drill which may include notification, classification, dose assessment, evacuation, and/or re-entry. Controllers and observers will be provided with a copy of the drill scenario on the date of the drill.

The drill will be held at the reactor site in the Burlington Engineering Laboratory on campus starting at 8 AM. The initial meeting place will be in the Control Room, (Room 2130). Duration of the drill will be approximately five hours with a drill critique immediately following termination.
