Over the past few months, the NRC has had an extensive staff of personnel at the Comanche Peak site to evaluate various technical issues, allegations, and concerns regarding the construction of the facility. As you are aware, it is particularly important that all relevant concerns known by interested parties be promptly identified to the staff so that they can be considered in the overall assessment of the construction of the Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station.

We have worked closely with you to identify issues relevant to Comanche Peak and to arrange for direct interviews with concerned parties associated with GAP. However, as discussed between you and Mr. R. Wessman of my staff on August 29, 1984, several parties remain unidentified by GAP and potential issues known by you have not been revealed to the NRC.

To assure appropriate evaluation of concerns known to GAP, the NRC requests a prompt identification of these concerns, along with the names and locations of the concerned individuals.
