Dear Mr. Carter:

As discussed by telephone with Mr. John Estridge of your staff, our Office agrees to extend the approval of the maintenance chemical trial using sodium bromide for control of biological growth in the two (2) recirculating cooling towers systems at the Catawba Nuclear Station in York County. Our Office approves this request with the following conditions:

- 1) This trial extension is approved until July 1, 1996.
- A minimum dilution of one (1) part RC cooling tower blowdown water to two (2) parts 2) once through RL cooling water (1:2) must be maintained.
- During the trial, internal Outfall 005 shall be limited to a monthly average of 0.2 mg/l 3) and a instantaneous maximum of 0.5 mg/l for Free Available Oxidants.

The modifications to the Catawba Nuclear Steam Station NPDES Permit No. SC0004278 should be finalized by July 1, 1996. These modifications incorporate the permanent use of sodium bromide as a maintenance chemical to the cooling towers.
