SUBJECT: TIMELINESS AND QUALITY OF GE NUCLEAR ENERGY (GE) SUBMITTALS

As we quickly approach the schedule date for the completion of the staff's evaluation of the Standard Safety Analysis Report (SSAR) for the GE Advanced Boiling Water Reactor (ABWR), it becomes imperative that GE meet or exceed its commitment dates for submittals required for issue resolution. Recently at the May management meeting, GE committed to providing information by May 23, 1992, regarding the design basis tornado design features. The staff received a document by fax on May 28, 1992, from GE which provided some preliminary information as SSAR handwritten revisions. At this point in the review, delays of several days have a definite cascading impact on the staffs ability to complete the FSER on schedule. We can no longer tolerate any delay of submittals in any area of the review.

Further, in the submittal discussed above, GE indicated that based on the possing design change for the reactor building superstructure and the roof purions, several sections of SSAR Chapter 3 and appendices will need to be revised. Please provide a firm submittal date for the necessary changes by June 3, 1992, so that the staff can determine the impact of the additional raview effort.
