Dear Mr. Chairman and Board Members:

On November 8, 1991, we the undersigned Donald W. DelCore, Sr., Instrument Specialist and Timothy [unclear] Electrician were terminated from our jobs by one of your subsidiaries, Northeast Utilities. While we were fired under the guise of disrupting the work force, the work place and inhibiting the safe operation of our nuclear facilities, we contend we were fired for raising nuclear safety and industrial safety concerns with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and O.S.H.A. Our cases are well documented with all the various agencies, and would serve no purpose to try to resurrect them at this point.

As you are aware the license transfer to NAEC (a Northeast Utilities subsidiary) from the Seabrook Nuclear Power Station is proposed, and is before you for what appears to be a final decision. We implore you not to allow this transfer to take place. The very Corporate Management who supervises the operation of the Millstone Nuclear Facilities and all of its support facilities will ultimately supervise the operation of Seabrook Nuclear Facilities.

This transfer cannot take place. It will jeopardize the safety and well-being of the citizens and employees in the area of the plant by the same suppression of concerns which has taken place at the Millstone plants and facilities.


Additionally, we would hope that you would consider suspending the licenses of all the Northeast Utilities Nuclear facilities at least until a complete investigation is accomplished and proper adjudication can take place before the Commission.


