As you are aware the license transfer to NAEC (a Northeast Utilities subsidiary) from the Seabrook Nuclear Power Station is proposed, and is before you for what appears to be a final decision. We implore you not to allow this transfer to take place. The very Corporate Management who supervises the operation of the Millstone Nuclear Facilities and all of its support facilities will ultimately supervise the operation of Seabrook Nuclear Facilities.

This transfer cannot take place. It will jeopardize the satety and well-being of the citizens and employees in the area of the plant by the same suppression of concerns which has taken place at the Millstone plants and facilities.

Additionally, we would hope that you would consider suspending the licenses of all the Northeast Utilities Nuclear facilities at least until a complete investigation is accomplished and proper adjudication can take place before the Commission.
