This refers to the routine resident inspection by Messrs. S. K. Chaudhary and J. T. Wiggins on July 1 - 31, 1984 at the Limerick Generating Station, Limerick, Pennsylvania. That inspection consisted of observation of activities, interviews, and document reviews, and the results have been discussed with Messrs. J. M. Corcoran and G. M. Leitch of your staff.

No violations of NRC requirements were identified and no reply to this letter is required. However, your increased attention toward closure of open inspection items is required. As discussed in the attached report, fourteen of fifty-seven items reviewed by our inspectors could not be closed either because your actions were not yet completed or because further information was required to verify the adequacy of your actions. In order to support timely closure of the remaining open items, you should consider actions to improve the adequacy of the documentation packages for those items offered as ready for closure.

In addition, this acknowledges receipt of your letter dated July 3, 1984 in response to our letter dated January 10, 1984, and your letter dated July 19, 1984 in response to our letter dated June 20, 1984. Thank you for informing us of the corrective and preventive actions documented in those letters.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within ten days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within thirty days of the date of this letter. Such application must comply with 10 CFR 2.790(b)(1).


