We have reviewed your 10 CFR 50.54(a) submittal dated May 15, 1992, which incorporated changes to your Operational Quality Assurance Program (OQAM) as a result of the March 10, 1992, meeting in the Region III office, and subsequent discussions between M. J. Spraul of the NRC and Mr. J. Gearhart of your staff on May 1, 1992. We understand this submittal replaces your January 3, 1992 submittal in its entirety.

Based on our review of your May 15, 1992 revision, we conclude that the reductions in commitment contained therein, continue to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix B, and are acceptable. Our approval is based, in part, on the Proposed Corrective Action Program flow chart, and Mr. J. Laux statement, during the March 10 meeting, that the approximately 700 man-hours per year saved by the elimination of the QA Department requirement to evaluate and verify less significant conditions adverse to quality will be used to audit a much larger sample of more significant conditions adverse to quality.

If there are changes to QA commitments existing in docketed correspondence outside of the Quality Assurance Program description, you are obligated to notify this office.
