Pursuant to the Board's order during the last conference call, we are attaching herewith subject Answer. Perhaps one day I'll be able to read the transcripts and find out what Applicants', Staff's, and CASE's own witnesses had to say. I will, however, never be able to forget the feeling that I have let our witnesses down by not at least being available to lend them moral support during their inquisition depositions.
