I trust that this will meet with the Board's approval, especially since Mr. Walsh relies upon it in his Affidavit (which is CASE's Answer).

I regret that I will be unable to attend any of the Intimidation hearings, due to the heavy work load currently being experienced. Perhaps one day I'll be able to read the transcripts and find out what Applicants', Staff's, and CASE's own witnesses had to say. I will, however, never be able to forget the feeling that I have let our witnesses down by not at least being available to lend them moral support during their inquisition depositions.


