Subject: Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station, Unit 1 Final Draft Technical Specifications

Enclosed are the Comanche Peak, Unit 1 Technical Specifications in final draft form. These Technical Specifications were developed utilizing the Westinghouse Standard Technical Specifications (W-STS), Revision 4, as a basis. They reflect plant-specific design requirements, new regulatory requirements issued since the development of the W-STS, Revision 4, and operating experience from other recently licensed Westinghouse nuclear plants.

The draft Technical Specifications were provided to your staff by letter dated July 1, 1983, and to the NRC for review and comment during the formal Proof and Review phase. The NRC staff and your staff's comments were reviewed during this review phase, and applicable comments were incorporated, including those obtained during a meeting at the plant site on August 1-2, 1984. The meeting in August 1984 was held to provide additional assurance that the enclosed final draft accurately reflects the results of the several review iterations which transpired throughout the Proof and Review phase. Except as noted below, the Technical Specifications to be issued as Appendix A to the Comanche Peak Unit 1 license, are expected to be essentially identical to the enclosed final draft.

Issues still to be resolved by the NRC staff include the RCS measurement uncertainty for N-16 instrumentation, DNB indicated values, correct cooldown curve for RCS, and qualifications of the 12-inch purge valve. The resolution of these issues may involve changes to the enclosed specifications where applicable. Any further changes requested by your staff, other than those required to correct editorial and/or typographical errors, will require that the changes be formally made and docketed in the PDR.

It is requested that your staff review the enclosed final draft, and that you submit under oath or affirmation, and as amended to your application, confirmation that the enclosed draft, or a revised draft incorporating any further changes you believe are necessary, accurately reflect the plant as built, the FSAR, and the SER analyses.
