Gentlemen:

The following applications were filed with the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (ONRR) for review in connection with the Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station:

- An August 2, 1982 request for exemption from the schedular requirements for installation of isolation condenser high point vents. A Class III fee (\$4,000) was remitted with your request pursuant to 10 CFR 170.22 of the March 23, 1978 regulations.
- A May 1, 1984 Technical Specification Change Request No. 122 relating to: (a) changes in location for three marine woodborer exposure panels, and (b) revised procedure for calibration of environmental mon^s toring instrumentation. A Class II fee (\$1,200) was remitted with your application pursuant to 10 CFR 170.22 of the March 23, 1978 regulations.

Based on information provided by the ONRR staff, it has been determined that:

1. A refund of \$4,000 is appropriate for Item 1 above. It is current NRC policy to exempt from fees exemption requests which were filed prior to June 20, 1984, that are approved pursuant to 10 CFP 50.12 by the ONRR staff unless a license amendment or other approval is also required. On this basis, we have concluded that an exemption pursuant to 10 CFR 170.11(b), from the fee requirements is authorized by law and such exemption is otherwise in the public interest and is hereby granted for that portion of your August 2 application which was not withdrawn by your letter dated July 13, 1984. Your Corporation was notified of the ONRR staff's approval of your August 2 application by letter dated August 9, 1984.

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GPU Nuclear Corporation

 A Class III fee (\$4,000) is appropriate for Item 2 since the review will involve consideration of a single safety issue. Therefore, an additional sum of \$2,800 is due for this application.

On the one hand, a refund of \$4,000 is due your Corporation and, on the other hand, \$2,800 is due the USNRC. We are applying \$2,800 of the \$4,000 refund due your Corporation for Item 1 above to the \$2,800 due the USNRC for Item 2 above. Therefore, we are concurrently authorizing the Division of Accounting and Finance to refund \$1,200 to your Corporation. We hope this transaction meets with your approval. If the ONRR staff's final review of Item 2 reveals that this fee is not appropriate, you will be notified and any necessary adjustments will be made.
