LICENSEE'S SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO THREE
MILE ISLAND ALERT'S FIRST SET OF INTERROGATORIES

Supp. Response to Interrogatory No. 39

Mr. Gary Miller has provided the following statement:

I cannot today recall the details of the conversation with Mr. G. Troffer or of any discussions with the state that I may have described to him. I have reviewed some of my earlier testimony (principally that before the NRC I&E on November 10, 1980, and the Statement of G.P. Miller on the March 28, 1979 TMI Incident) relative to those subjects and from this plus my memory of the circumstances conclude the following.

I would have avoided communicating specific systems details which would have required excessive time on my part to impart both the full understanding of how the primary and secondary systems react on a loss of feedwater trip and then explain the reaction of all parameters. Additionally, as I have previously testified, I would have counted on the "Command Team" members who were on a continuous direct line to the state (in accordance with the approved TMI Radiological Emergency Plan) to communicate a lot of specific information rather than tie myself personally to that. At that time, I had many other responsibilities demanding immediate attention.

I cannot today recall specific discussions with the NRC at or about 0930, March 28, 1979.

The transcript of the November 10, 1980 I&E interview will be placed in the Discovery Room.
