Dear Mr. Schnell:

We have received your letter dated April 7, 1992, which transmitted Revision 15 to the Callaway Plant's Radiological Emergency Response Plan. We have reviewed Revision 15 and have determined that it is acceptable and does not degrade the effectiveness of your emergency planning for the Callaway Plant.

Revision 15 includes several refinements to the plant's emergency action levels regarding indications of events such as fuel damage, abnormal inplant radiation levels and loss of heat sink. The revision also includes updated information on the plant's normal organization and the emergency public information organization. The exposure limit for life-saving actions has been revised to correspond to current Federal guidance. Information regarding local support organizations and associated letters of agreement has been updated. Revision 15 includes numerous examples where redundant material has been eliminated and where minor editing has improved the quality of the text.
