
for the purpose of requiring the above-named individual to appear at a deposition to commence in this proceeding on September 20, 1984. A copy of the proposed Subpoena is attached.

Mr. Rogers can testify to matters concerning the "Dieckamp" mailgram and related events.



to any matter in issue, or (2) condition denial of the motion on just and reasonable grounds.
