

The purpose of this letter is to notify the Nuclear Regulatory Commission of the resumption of active duties by a licensed individual (Docket Number 55-21383). By letter dated February 19, 1992 (Serial: NLS-92-048), Carolina Power & Light Company informed the NRC of the removal of the licensed individual from active reactor operator duty due to a temporary physical disability.
