On July 18, 1991, the NRC issued Generic Letter (GL) 91-11 which contained the staff resolution of Generic Issues 48 and 49. The GL required that licensees certify that procedures exist which contain time limitations and surveillance requirements for vital instrument buses (VIB), inverters, or other onsite power sources for VIB and tie breakers. If procedures do not exist, a justificaiton demonstrating the reasons why the controls are not needed is required.

By letters dated January 29 and May 1, 1992, you responded to the GL. You indicated that procedures for time limitations and surveillance requirements are in-place or will soon be implemented at Prairie Island. Where procedures do not exist, you provided justification as to why the controls are not needed.

The staff has reviewed your response and finds that it meets the reporting requirements set forth in GL 91-11. This completes the staff's activities on Tr. Nos. M82453 and M82454.
