

The backup Emergency Operations Facility (EOF) for the Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station is located approximately twenty-five (25) miles south of the station in the Corporate Office of South Carolina Electric and Gas Company (SCE&G) in Columbia, South Carolina. Approval from the Staff on this location was received by SCE&G in a letter from D. G. Eisenhut to O. W. Dixon, Jr., dated May 9, 1984. This backup EOF is now fully operational and has been considered functional since June 10, 1983 when Revision 10 to the Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station Emergency Plan was implemented.
