SUBJECT: ACTIONS IN RESPONSE TO TROPICAL STORM DIANA

This PN updates PNO-II-84-59F, issued on September 13, 1984.

At 6 p.m. on September 13, hurricane warnings were discontinued and Diana was downgraded to a tropical storm.

As of 6 a.m. today, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration said that the poorly defined center of Tropical Storm Diana was near latitude 35.2 north and longitude 77.7 west, approximately 90 miles north of the Brunswick site, with maximum wind speeds of approximately 40 mph. Diana was moving at near 10 mph in an east-northeast direction.

The Brunswick site Technical Support Center was deactivated at 6 p.m. on 9-13 after a second source of offsite power to Unit 1 was restored.

Region II is continuing to monitor the storm track.

Region II has maintained contact with the States of North Carolina and South Carolina and has kept the Regional FEMA and EPA offices informed.

Unless unexpected conditions occur, there will be no further updates on Tropical Storm Diana.
