Ted:

Enclosed is a map of a portion of the ANC project showing the mine spoil pile south of Pond #1. The map includes contours depicting the surface to be left after the AML program removes a portion of the pile. Their contours are based on the assumption that the ANC project will construct a channel so that there will be positive drainage from the reclaimed pond surface to the Southwest diversion. On the map I have pencilled in the approximate alignment of the channel. We need to talk about the profile of this channel, which will begin at approximately 6480' and will drop to its outlet at about 6420 - 6430'. The diversion channel will need to be about 5-6 feet deep. The Bullrush Heap material relocation leveled the surface of Pond #1 at about 6438' and the final radon cover will be at about 6443 to 6444'. Give me a call as soon as you can. AML's plans for borrow from this area may change depending on the outcome of our conversation.
